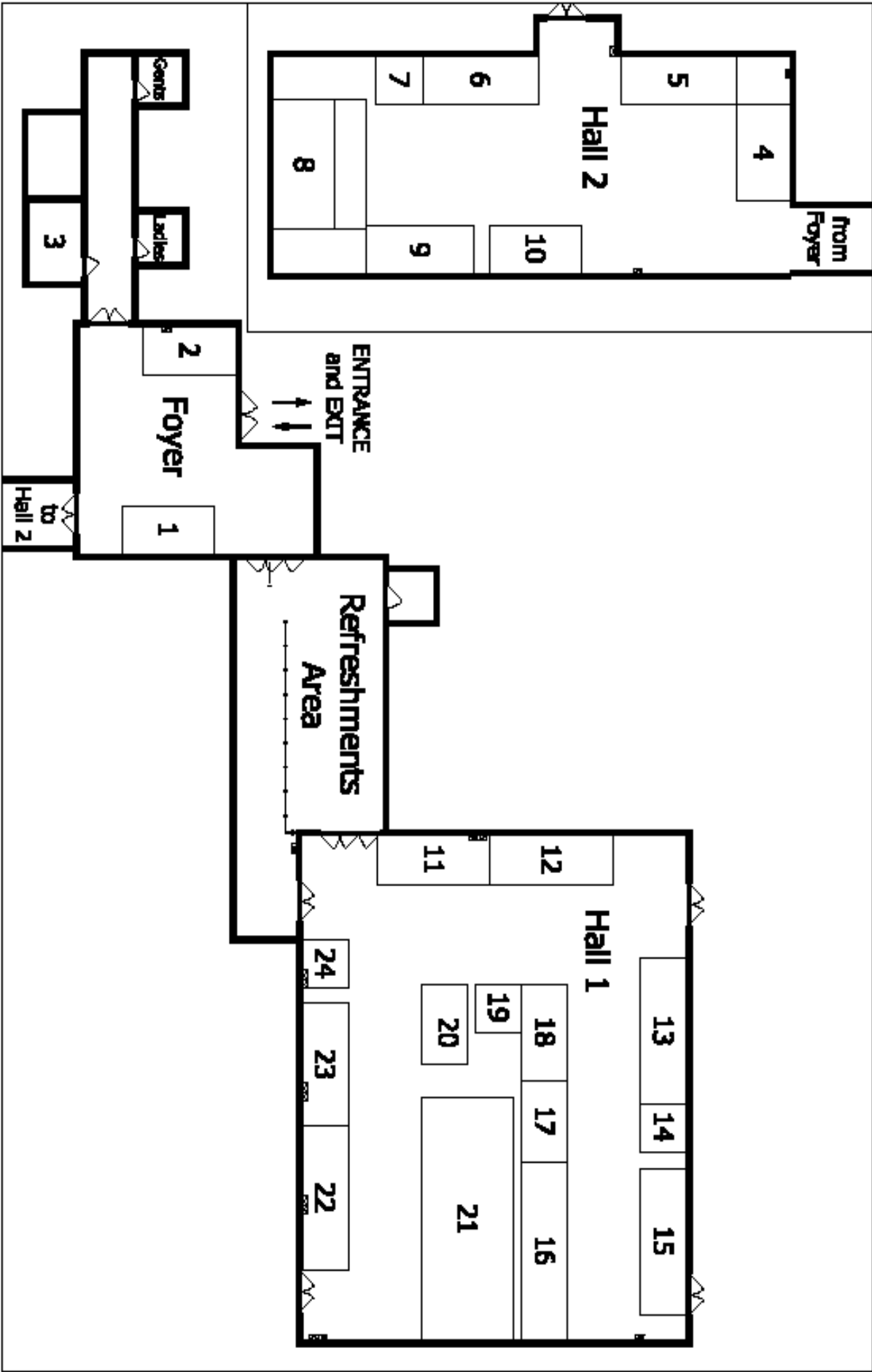

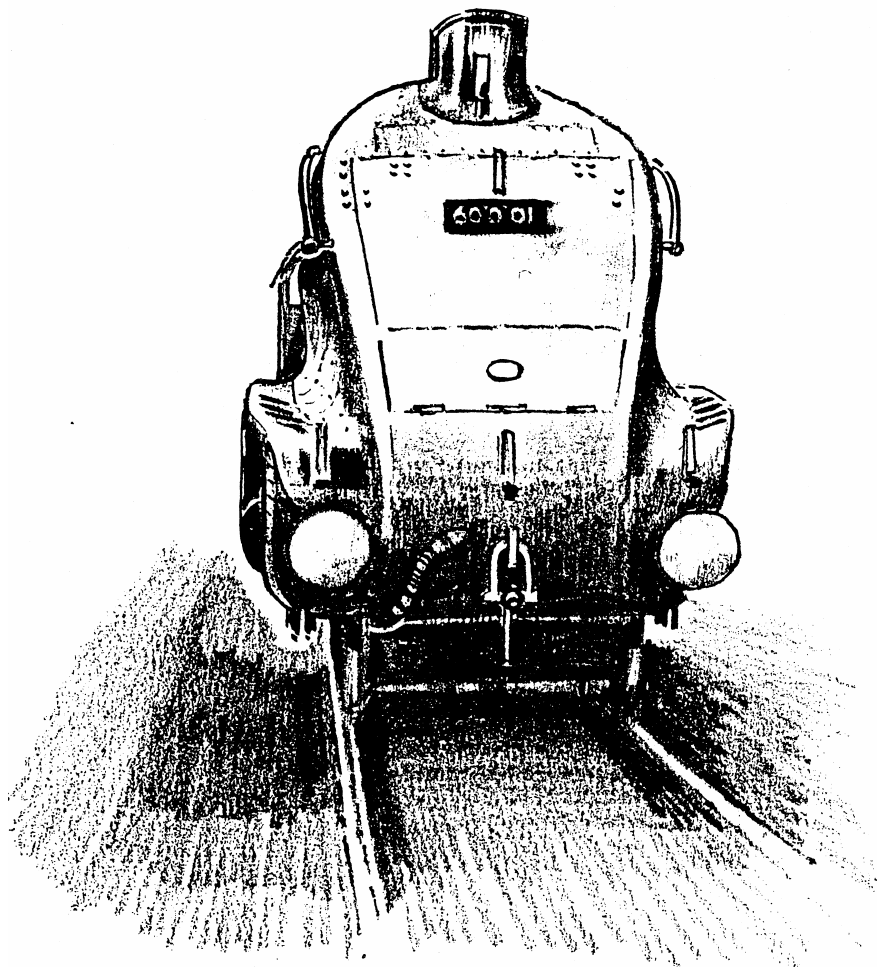

8. SUTTON FOLLY - '00' Gauge - An opportunity to drive the trains yourself. Exhibited by Pete Cullen & Andy Smyth (Sutton Coldfield RS)
9. BURWARTON - '0' GAUGE - A depiction of the prototype station located on the Cleobury Mortimer & Ditton Priors Light Railway during the late 1930s. The layout is built on a metal ironing board. Exhibited by Alan Searle (Sutton Coldfield RS).

11. SAND WELL COUNTRY – ‘N’ Gauge - A secondary route in the Nevada wilderness set during the 1930s and 1940s. Exhibited by Nick Tilston (Warley MRC).
12. SOWTERS LANE – ‘009’ GAUGE – A narrow gauge layout based on the practice of Welsh Slate Quarry Railways. Traffic also includes a regular passenger service and occasional freight. Exhibited by Soar Valley MRC.

17. BURTON HALT AND TERMINUS – ‘N’ Gauge – A small GWR station now extended to run into a larger terminal station with expanded facilities. Exhibited by John Burton
18. SNEYD SIDINGS – ‘00’ Gauge – A fictitious railway/canal interchange facility, located near Bloxwich on the edge of the south Cannock coal field, set during the 1950s & 60s. Exhibited by John Hill.
19. THE LANE - ‘N’ Gauge - A small fuelling and stabling point located on the outskirts of a large urban area, set during the post-privatisation period 1996 – 2004. Exhibited by Peter Johnson.
20. Wolverhampton Scalextric Club’s portable track your opportunity to drive the cars.
21. STOKE SUMMIT- ‘00’ Gauge – The layout is a representation of the prototype located approximately 5 miles south of Grantham, at around 350ft (105m) above sea level, this is the highest point on the East Coast Main Line between London and Edinburgh. Mallard’s record high speed occurred a few miles to the south. The layout depicts the 1958 – 1963 period. Exhibited by Wolverhampton MRC.
